We continually talk to the children about helping others and I was incredibly proud this week when a group of year 6 girls asked if they could host a fundraising event for Cancer Research. On Tuesday after school this week Zaira, Hafsa, Aminah and Aamina will be selling various things in the playground to raise money, please support generously. Thank you.

## Ramadan

We are aware that many of our families are currently fasting for the holy month of Ramadan. As a school we feel our **Year 6** children, in consultation with parents, are mature enough to make an informed decision when choosing to fast. We would however, like to remind parents that it is a long school day and the children are very active. Guidance states that children of primary school age may want to do a **partial fast** which is best done under parental supervision after school hours or at the weekend, which we have talked to the children about. The health and safety of our children is our number one priority and we appreciate your support at this time. Please speak to me if you have any concerns.
