Outcomes/Impact

- Teachers are more confident with delivering good/outstanding PE lessons to pupils after working alongside specialist coaches from Getsportsactive. High quality CPD provided by Bishop Challoner Sports Partnership also gave teachers increased confidence and skill level.
- Change in swimming provision has ensured that more children are now swimming further distances unaided and have increased confidence levels in the water
- All key stage 2 children have taken part in intra school competition for Basketball, Football, Hockey, Cricket,
- Holy Family have taken part in inter school competition for Basketball, Football, Hockey, Athletics, Cricket
- There has been a significant increase in participation levels for extracurricular sports clubs, these have included: Taekwondo, Dance, Cricket, Football, Multi skills, Gymnastics
- On June 16th the whole school took part in out sports day at King Edwards School. The children competed at a high quality facility which raised aspirations for future achievement.
