Year 6 Termly Learning plan

Subject	Focus
Religious Education	<p><u>Baptism & Confirmation</u> The children will learn about the celebration of the Sacraments of Baptism and Confirmation, including the signs and symbols of both of these Sacraments.</p> <p><u>The People of God</u> This unit gives the children the opportunity to develop their knowledge of the structure of the Bible, particularly the Old Testament.</p> <p><u>Advent</u> The children will look in more detail at the stories leading up to Jesus' birth on Christmas Day.</p>
English	<p>The children will focus on narrative and biographies this term. They will focus on understanding and applying new sentence structures to their writing and learning a greater variety of punctuation. Reading will be based around non-fictional works to support the writing units.</p>
Mathematics	<p>The children will continue to develop their knowledge of place value as well as their written methods of the four operations and apply these skills to a variety of given problems. They will practice mental mathematical skills regularly to improve speed and confidence.</p>
Science	<p><u>Light:</u> The children will learn about light travelling in straight lines, how we see things and how shadows are created.</p> <p><u>Electricity:</u> The children will create their own circuits using various components and will learn about the symbols that represent these components.</p>
Physical Education	<p><u>Gymnastics</u> The children will develop their balancing skills and sequencing using stretch and tuck movements. They will develop their movements to include larger apparatus in a partnered sequence.</p> <p><u>Dance</u> The children will learn to create patterns and sequences in larger groups and develop their creative side by recreating the Haka.</p>
ICT	<p><u>We are App Makers</u> The children will use new software to understand, create and promote an app for a smartphone or tablet device. They will learn new vocabulary and improve their enterprising skills with an interview to promote the app.</p>
PSHE	<p><u>New Beginnings</u> The children will consider their new start in Year 6, thinking about personal aims for the year and improving relationships within the classroom. They will look at their friendships and family and reflect on their positive and negative behaviours.</p>
Theme led learning: Humanities/Art/ DT	<p><u>Poland</u> The children will learn about our class saint, St. John-Paul II as well as cooking some traditional Polish food. They will also learn to create their own Polish folk dances and create different pieces of Polish art.</p>
