Coronavirus symptoms

Dear Parents/Guardians

An important reminder - if your child or anyone else in your household displays any of these symptoms:

- New continuous cough
- High temperature
- Loss of taste or smell

If a child displays any of these symptoms then the whole household **MUST** isolate and arrange a Covid 19 test.

Those with symptoms must isolate for 10 days or until they receive a negative Covid 19 test result

Family members isolating without symptoms must isolate for 14 days or until the family member with symptoms has a negative Covid 19 test result.

We cannot accept children back into school without evidence of a negative test result or proof that your child has isolated for 10 days from first contact with school (14 days if a member of the household is positive or they are not showing symptoms). When your child does return to school they will need to return through the office entrance.

This is Government law. Anyone failing to follow these guidelines can face a fine of £1000. With the current increase in cases across the country and particularly in the Small Heath area, it is vital that we all work together to keep our school family safe.
