Intent

We deliver an Art curriculum to all pupils that enables them to deepen their understanding of a variety of techniques and collaborate in their use of drawing, painting and sculpture. The key expectations for the children are to develop ideas, master techniques and to take inspiration from the greats.

Autumn 2 – During this half term we worked with visiting Artist Sue Guthrie to create a Painting experience linked to our learning all about the Parables of Jesus in R.E.

Year 1 - Painting and stencilling



We used our Painting skills to create a painting of The Good Samaritan.

Using white paint to make the background colours lighter and mixing primary colours to make secondary colours. Stencilling the characters and using thick/thin paint brushes to create effect
